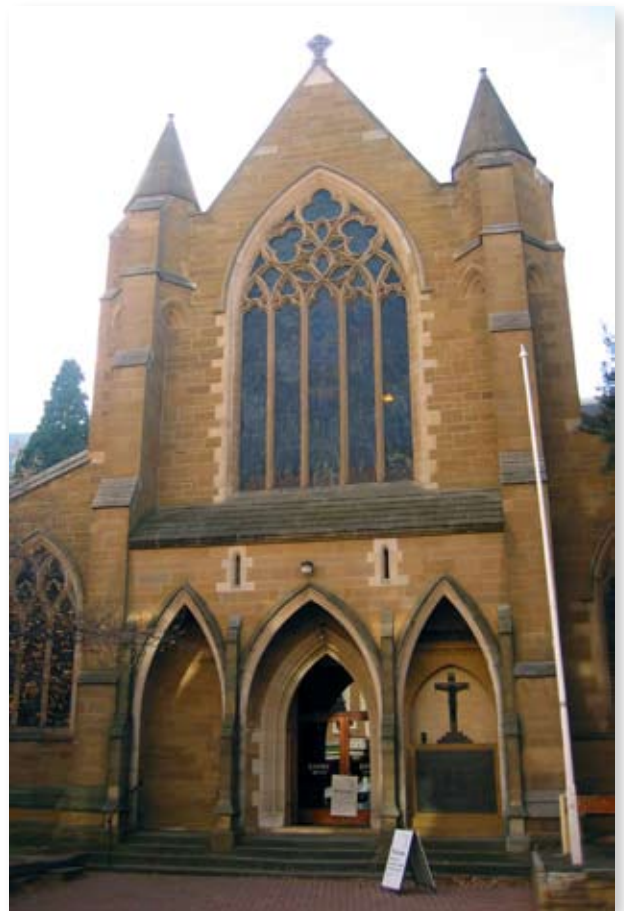

NATIONAL TRUST COMMUNITY HERITAGE PROGRAM

The National Trust Community Heritage Program has been established to support and encourage community participation in, learning from, enjoying and valuing Tasmania's historic environment.

The Community Heritage Program has a number of elements that support a wide range of community initiatives. These elements include the:

- Heritage Conservation Appeals Program – which offers the opportunity for community groups to establish tax deductible gift programs for heritage conservation projects in Tasmania.
- Heritage Auspicing Program – which enables the National Trust to sponsor non-incorporated bodies with an interest in cultural heritage when applying for grants and other support.
- Heritage Assistance Program – which enables the National Trust to support local and specialist heritage activities through the provision of professional advice by the Trust's staff and volunteers.
- Heritage Co-operative Promotional Program – which aims to encourage the development of joint marketing initiatives involving community managed heritage sites and collections and the National Trust.
- Heritage Publications Support Program – which encourages and supports the production of high quality publications that document aspects of Tasmania's heritage
- Heritage Local Support Program – which enables the National Trust to support local heritage initiatives through access to and use of the Trust's heritage property portfolio.



- Heritage Emergency Documentation Program – which enables the National Trust to support heritage groups, community organisations and local government to document threatened cultural heritage.
- Tasmanian Heritage Festival – which promotes Tasmanian heritage organisations, their programs and their importance to the state. The Tasmanian Heritage Festival is co-ordinated by the National Trust.
- Tasmanian Heritage Exhibition Touring Program – which enable small exhibitions on aspects of Tasmania's heritage to tour to regional and local venues throughout Tasmania.
